■ Residential Services

Host Home Program – Mosaic provides services to people with intellectual disabilities in a family-like or roommate setting. Host Homes offer the least restrictive, most natural living environment and help people achieve the highest degree of life satisfaction and personal goals. People who receive these services get personal attention, consistent support from the same person, one-on-one contact between provider and family member or guardian, and regular monitoring for those with healthcare needs.
