
Prescription Medication

Health Care Access Clinic is a unique, non-profit health care facility for Douglas County residents who have limited income and no health insurance. The agency is a community based service supported by local resources including more than 140 volunteer health care professionals and organizations. The services available include a health clinic, referrals for tests and specialists, and assistance with prescription medication.

Who is eligible to use Health Care Access?

You must meet the three following criteria:

- 1. Resident of Douglas County
- 2. Without health coverage (insurance, medical card, etc.)
- 3. Meet our Income Guidelines:

Who is not eligible?

People who can be seen at:

- 1. University Health centers
- 2. Indian Health services
- 3. Veterans Administration, etc.

How to obtain services through Health Care Access:

- 1. For information on eligibility, services or to set up an appointment, call 841-5760 or stop by
- 2. Current proof of income must be presented at the first appointment.
- 3. It is helpful if you can also bring past medical records and a list of all medications you are currently taking.

Is there a fee?

A \$10 fee is requested. No one is denied care due to inability to pay.
